Treasurers Report

- Donations through October 10th roughly match expenditures
- <u>Minuted</u> Meeting will defer payment of approximately \$900 balance of SEYM apportionment due to potential costs of relocating.
- Minuted Meeting will pay the \$48 annual subscription fee to Friends Journal plus a donation of \$52 (total \$100).
- Minuted Meeting will donate \$50 from our building fund to the Tampa Meeting House fund.
- Minuted Meeting will donate \$100 to Florida Coalition for Peace & Justice for repairs to the peace education center.

 1st issue.

JAX AVP

Our local project was acknowledged by FIBM attenders the Peace and Social Concerns Committee of SEYM as a JAX Meeting ministry

- The Peace and Social Concerns Committee of SEYM offered funds to help with travel and hospitality for Friends attending Advanced or Facilitator workshops, as well as to help JAX Meeting host workshops
- The Peace and Social Concerns Committee of SEYM was impressed by the diversity of JAX AVP's group: former inmates, social workers, veterans, AME church members, etc.
